- ***Chicka Chicka Boom Boom***- by Bill Martin Jr: In this lively alphabet rhyme, the letters of the alphabet race up the coconut tree. Will there be enough room? Oh, no - Chicka Chicka Boom! Boom!
- ***We're Going on a Bear Hunt***- by Michael Rosen: *We're going on a bear hunt. We're going to catch a big one. Will you come too?* For more than twenty-five years readers have been swishy swashing and splash splashing through this award-winning favorite. Join in the fun!
- ***The Grouchy Ladybug***: by Eric Carle: *The Grouchy Ladybug* has delighted readers of all ages with the story of a bad-tempered bug who won't say "please" or "thank you," won't share, and thinks she is bigger and better than anyone else. Readers will love how this testy ladybug introduces them to many new animals and learns that maybe being grouchy isn't always the best option.
- ***Adventures of Frog and Toad***: by Arnold Lobel: Meet Frog and Toad as they discover the true meaning of friendship. Sometimes it is not so easy, like the day Frog goes off by himself, leaving Toad to worry that he's lost his friend.
- ***How To be a Friend***: by Laurie Krasny Brown: Fun dinosaur characters teach young children all about friendship—the value of friends, how to make friends, and how to be a good friend.
