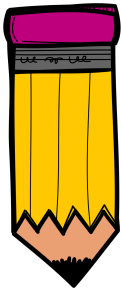

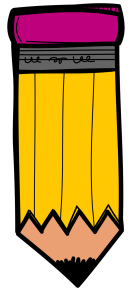
Students entering Kindergarten Summer Reading List

*Choose TWO books from the list. Once the books are finished choose one of the two and create a new cover page for the story.

- ***Chicka Chicka Boom Boom***- by Bill Martin Jr: In this lively alphabet rhyme, the letters of the alphabet race up the coconut tree. Will there be enough room? Oh, no - Chicka Chicka Boom! Boom!
- ***The Panda Problem***: by Deborah Underwood: Every story needs a problem. But Panda doesn't have a problem. Unless...Panda is the problem. Just who is the main character of this story? A funny book about how books work.
- ***The Grouchy Ladybug***: by Eric Carle: *The Grouchy Ladybug* has delighted readers of all ages with the story of a bad-tempered bug who won't say "please" or "thank you," won't share, and thinks she is bigger and better than anyone else. Readers will love how this testy ladybug introduces them to many new animals and learns that maybe being grouchy isn't always the best option.
- ***How To be a Friend***: by Laurie Krasny Brown: Fun dinosaur characters teach young children all about friendship—the value of friends, how to make friends, and how to be a good friend.
- ***How to Be Kind in Kindergarten***: by D.J. Steinberg: *How to Be Kind in Kindergarten* is from the best-selling author of the hugely popular *Kindergarten, Here I Come!*, here's a guidebook in verse that shows children how to be kind in the new and exciting world of kindergarten.
