Entering the Building

Introduction

Entering the building every morning is the activity, which unofficially begins the day. It is important, that this is smooth, stress free, efficient and conducted in a manner that keeps children safe.

Philosophy

A foundational premise when designing a safe entry throughout the day and controlling transmission of any virus is to help keep it from the building. During the entry into the building social distancing and hand sterilization will be implemented. The use of hand sanitation and social distancing is recommended by the CDC and other health agencies to help control the spread of any viruses and manage any possible outbreaks.

Process

- 1. Parents are responsible to take the temperatures of children before they leave home. A contract will be sent home through Google forms.
- 2. Students will immediately sanitize their hands by using sanitizers at the main doors.
- 3. Buses will drop the students off at the driveway; the crossing guard will be there to direct students.
- 4. Students arriving by car will be dropped off in the Queen of Peace Church parking lot.
- 5. Staff will monitor the main entrance and remind students to sanitize their hands and to social distance in the hallways.
- 6. Parents may not enter the building at this time.
- 7. A Mask will be required to enter the building.
- 8. Students will store their mask in a storage bag when/if they remove it.
- 9. After prayers in the morning, teachers will review the daily monitoring health checklist with the students.
