Introduction

The organization of the classroom is important in supporting the academic progress of students. The use of a variety of materials is essential for learning. This includes: books, writing instruments and materials for special area subjects.

Philosophy

Foundational premises when designing a safe classroom environment are the concepts of maintaining cohorts, social distancing and frequent cleaning. The CDC and other health agencies recommend these practices to help control the spread of any viruses and also manage any possible outbreaks.

Process

- 1. Students may not share school supplies. Each classroom will have extra supplies. However, it is essential that each student has their own Supplies daily.
- 2. Each student will have a plastic container to store items that do not fit in the desk.
- 3. Desk and materials will be cleaned during the day.
- 4. Students will be reminded to sanitize their hands during the day.
- 5. Each room will have a no touch hand-sanitizing machine.
- 6. Honors Math students need a small tote bag or cinch sack to carry their books back and forth to class.
