Dear Parents and Students:

Welcome to 4th grade! I really look forward to meeting all of you in September. In the meantime, here is what you can do to get ready.

1. Put this note and packet in a safe place till you are ready to think about school again – you all need a break first!

2. When you are ready, please look at this packet. You will find:



- This letter with general information.
 - A summer math and ELA packet. The goal of this packet is to safeguard all the hard work accomplished in 3rd grade. There are 20 days in the packet (2 days for each of the 10 weeks of summer off starting week 2.) **This should be turned in the day we come back to school.**
 - A book list and book report form. Choose one of the books from the list and read it. Then complete the attached book report form using complete sentences, good handwriting, and by following directions carefully. **Bring the book and report in September, and we will share with each other about our summer reading.**
3. PLEASE be sure students come to 4th grade with most of the times tables still memorized (up to 10 X 10.) That was a large part of 3rd grade math, and those skills need to be maintained. They could quickly fall behind without those tables at their fingertips. We will work on speed of recall, but please work on any that are weak and maintain the ones that are strong.
 4. Please go to Google Classroom and see that students are already set up in our 4th grade class. A copy of all this information will be in a post there in case anything gets misplaced. Parents, if your child does not see the Grade 4 class, please send an email to me at steresa@gscregional.org and I will look into it. Students who are new to GSC will have access as soon as a school email is created by the school.
